

A Proposal

Alas this may happen in our country Hindustan!

1. **Income Tax should be abolished.**
2. **Loan to everyone @ 0.01% p.a. interest easily**, who is having either Caliber or Capacity or Potential or Qualification or any Special feature.
3. **Only three taxes i.e. Excise, Sales tax and Service tax** should be there instead of GST, with maximum rate of 10%. For the beginners these taxes should be progressive.
4. Limit of Income and Assets should be there for **eradication of Poverty.**
5. Equalization Tax on bank balances **for leaps and bounds progress of the country.**
6. Police reforms for **better security of the public** and Bureaucracy for **building a strong democracy.**
7. Judiciary reforms for **timely justice.**
8. Political reforms for **entry to only those politicians who really wish to serve the nation.**
9. Coins should be in circulation instead of currency notes for **eradication of Corruption.**
10. Ban on Arms & Ammunition (other than by Police and Army) for **eradication of Terrorism.**
11. One Rank One Pension (OROP) to everyone at present salary, who retired long back.
12. Temporary Teachers and Aanganwadi / Health workers should be made permanent at a respectable salary.
13. A special provision should be made for – Transgender (*Hijdas*) / Prostitutes / Dry toilet workers / Scavengers for their better life.
14. **A special provision should be made for a pension (Rs. 5000/- pm) to everyone who has crossed 60 years of age.** For permanent employees/workers it should be 2.5% pa for every year completed or 50% of salary whichever is more. Simultaneously a provision for family pension and Unemployment allowance should also be made.
15. **A special provision should be made for one time free food in a day to a woman and unemployed youth.** For this purpose Rs. 3000 p.m. in cities and Rs. 2000 p.m. in villages should be given.
16. All loans of farmers and students (who have studied within the country) should be waived off. Minimum Support Price should be raised by minimum of 50% for the farmers.
17. Every citizen should get basic necessities of life easily (food, clothing, housing, education, health services, security, water, electricity and transport) and it should be the responsibility of the government to provide that.

- 18 Every section of the society (student, farmer, laborer, employee and businessman/self employed) should get a guarantee of livelihood from the government.
- 19 A special provision should be made for the disabled (orphans/ old/ handicapped) to build such homes, wherein all of them can live together in a separate wing of the same complex with all the modern facilities / services which are required by them should be provided free. A provision for a school of Physiotherapy / Nursing should also be made available within these homes.
- 20 It should be the responsibility of the government that no one in the country is exploited or gets an undue advantage as happening in the case of pulses etc. Farmer is getting hardly Rs.30-40 per kg which is below Minimum Support Price but sometimes pulses are selling in the market up to Rs. 200 per kg. In the case of Petroleum products prices in the International market had gone down by more than 50% in the past few years but retail prices in the country were more than the prices which were prevalent at that time (2014).
- 21 Citizen / Business Information System, Banking System and Taxation System should be managed in such a fashion that the government can get complete information about every citizen of the country easily and is connected with everyone also. For this purpose a mobile phone should be provided free (in a family) to those who are not having at present, so that whole country is connected.
- 22 Golden Triangle Scheme, cleaning of all sources of water i.e. rivers, waterfalls, lakes, ponds, wells, water bodies etc, Rain water harvesting and provision of at least one pond in every village should be made for water management.
- 23 For Air management every citizen should plant and up bring a tree, cycle should ply within 5 km. and battery/ electricity operated vehicles should be encouraged.
- 24 For efficient transport system, a corridor of 1 km. wide should be built from Kashmir to Kanyakumari along with connecting all states and major cities with bullet trains, four lane railway lines, 18/ 14 lane highways and airports facilities.
- 25 In every village 50-100 houses should be built and provided free to homeless.
- 26 An arrangement to produce up to 1000 time solar power of the existing capacity should be made in coming 10 years.
- 27 For Tourism management 5-50 square km. infrastructure should be developed in every state. To promote domestic tourism it should be made compulsory for every citizen to go out for a month in a year and its funding should be made by the government only (This facility can be made available after 8-10 years, when infrastructure has been created in the Country).
- 28 To convert waste management into a goldmine, organic fertilizers should be produced in every colony of every city and every village.
- 29 A special attention should be given to Hilly farming, Plains farming and Ocean farming to make Backbone of the country (farmer) stronger. Organic fertilizer should be produced with the help waste management and that should be provided free to the farmers.
- 30 Every village of the country should be a modern one.

- 31 Every colony and city should be a modern one.
- 32 Cottage industries should be established in every village along with 50-100 houses.
- 33 Cooperative movement should be encouraged in every sphere of life.
- 34 Free distribution of goods and services should be organized and provided to the needy wherever required under Equalization tax for the elevation of the country.
- 35 Free training in every sphere of life should be provided for better prospects of livelihood.
- 36 Sports, social and cultural activities should be promoted in the country. A provision for a playground attached with every school should be made.
- 37 For pollution control and to make water, air and climate conducive for health, all efforts should be made on war footing.
- 38 To minimize social evils and to promote brotherhood in the society all out efforts should be made.
- 39 To improve respect for the women in the society, a provision should be made that an immovable property should be registered in the name of women only. It will help in reducing the problem of *Talak Talak Talak* and polygamy in Muslims, feticide and dowry to a great extent.
- 40 Property/ Profit of the country should be divided equally amongst countrymen (which is under the earth).
- 41 Distribution of money in the States should be on the basis of the population of a state.
- 42 Money belongs to the social/charitable organizations is of the public and should be used/spent for the public only.
- 43 Education and health services should be equal with resources and that too free.
- 44 Reservation policy should be such which unites the countrymen rather than breaking them. All such acts should be made by the government wherein the need for the Reservation may end/not arise (by implementation of the above provisions tremendous job and other opportunities will arise).
- 45 The person dealing in Drugs or Adulteration or keeping Arms and Ammunitions or encouraging Caste differentiation or dealing with Professional Blood donors/ Trading in Human organs should be treated as a traitor and should get a death penalty only. In these cases decision by all the three courts should be made/done and completed within 5 weeks and penalty should be executed in 6th week.

Role of money in this System

1. **Money required:** Money required for the above projects may be Rs. 10/20/50/100/500.....5000 lac crore that should be managed and organized by the government only.
2. **Role of money:-** Money is circulation only. If circulation is more, it means value of money is more. Other than this there is no role/ concept of money. In this system money circulation will multiply many folds than the money circulation at present.
3. **Foreign exchange:-** If some foreign exchange is required for the working of the country, it should be the responsibility of the government to manage that. It should be managed in such a fashion that one Rupee is equal to one Dollar in a short span of one year and equal to 100 Dollar within ten years.
4. **Benefit of this system:-** Every citizen will be benefited in this system either a poor, middle class or a rich. A rich will become richer and will remain a rich till he/ she is working for the nation (contributing towards business in the form of taxes or projects under Equalization tax) otherwise have to pay an Equalization tax. Money will always contribute for the progress, prosperity and elevation of the country.

Every citizen will have the best on the basis of one's caliber and potential. There will be no avenues for investments. There will be no fear and tension also.

A citizen is doing/working or the government is doing/working something, in both the cases country will be benefited and progress.

5. **Above all Honor according to one's contribution:** A provision to provide honor in the form of pension to those citizens who contributed towards taxes or projects (in a particular limit of their contribution) in their lifetime.

For example: In this system a person who contributed more than Rs. 500 crore towards taxes/projects in his lifetime, he will be entitled to a pension of Rs. 4 lac per month which will be an equivalent to the salary of the Prime Minister, means this man is not less than a P.M. Otherwise majority of the persons in this bracket will get a maximum salary of Rs. 3.99 lac per month.

The person who contributed between Rs. 50-500 crore will be entitled to a pension of Rs. 3 lac pm which will be an equivalent to the salary of the Chief Minister and majority of the persons in this bracket will be getting a salary maximum up to Rs. 2.99 lac pm.

In this system maximum salary in the country will be Rs. 5 lac pm and that will be of the President of the country which is the highest post of the country.

Purpose of all this

1. Only one and that is well being of the citizens of the country by which every citizen should get food, clothing, housing, education, health services, security, water, electricity and transport easily on the basis of one's caliber and potential. But the person who is lacking these (caliber or/and potential) should also get basic minimum necessities of life (as given above) easily.
2. Livelihood for every section of the society i.e. student, farmer, laborer, employee and businessman/self employed.
3. Every citizen should get respect, rights and opportunities.
4. All this should bring equality, improvement in their capacity and politeness in the society and the country.
5. Our Country marching towards progress and prosperity.

All this can be done/managed very easily and its only *Mantra/* formula are Unity.
