

Various issues and their solution related to How our country Hindustan can become a Heaven?

Our country will become a Heaven by having solution of the issues mentioned below and all issues have been discussed in brief along with a probable solution as under:-

1. **Black money and corruption:** To eradicate black money and corruption coins should be in circulation instead of currency notes. Anyone keeping cash more than Rs. 10000 should be treated as a traitor.
2. **Terrorism:** In addition to the circulation of coins, a ban should be imposed on keeping arms and ammunition other than by Police and Army. Anyone keeping arms and ammunition should be treated as a traitor and penalty should be death.
3. **Poverty:** A limit of Income and Asset should be fixed. **Limit of Income** – Minimum salary should be Rs. 5000 p.m. and maximum Rs. 5 lac p.m. Minimum pension should be Rs. 5000 p.m. for those who are not having any source of income and is above a particular age. Similarly minimum unemployment allowance should be Rs. 5000 p.m. **Limit of Assets** – Property i.e. one house/shop/agricultural land within 25 km aerial distance. Jewellery/Diamonds – for a woman 200gm/5 carat and for a man 50gm/1 carat, Car – One for the family of up to 5 members and business car a separate. Cash – Rs. 10000 per person in coins, Bank balances – Unlimited subject to Equalization tax.
4. **Fear, tension and manipulation:** To end all these, abolish Income tax.
5. **Humanistic tax structure:** For this purpose only three taxes should be there i.e. Excise, Sales tax and Service tax and with a maximum rate of 10% of any tax. A progressive taxation should be there for the beginners.
6. **Job and other opportunities:** Working hours for an employee should be 28 hours in a week and work should be done all the seven days. Loan to everyone @0.01% p.a. (interest of Rs. 1000.00 on a loan of Rs. one crore) interest who is having caliber or capacity or potential or qualification or any special feature. This loan should be disbursed to the beginners within 30 days from the date of proposal and there should not be any limit of amount. No collateral security. Negligible margin money @ 2% above the loan of Rs. 5 crore and maximum of 10%. **Margin money should also be made available under Equalization tax scheme by senior citizens only.**
7. **Day to day necessities:** Every citizen should get the necessities of day to day life according to their caliber and potential but a person who is having fewer calibers or potential must get food, clothing, housing, education, health services, security, water, electricity and transport easily.
8. **Livelihood to each section of the society:** Every section of the society i.e. student, farmer, laborer, employee or businessman/self employed should get the guarantee of livelihood on the basis of one's caliber and potential. A special arrangement should be made for transgender/hijdas and prostitutes also.
9. **Disabled (includes orphans/old/ handicapped):** To provide comfortable and better life to all the disabled, at least one home should be built in every block of villages or every city, where all of them can live together in a separate wing of the same complex.

10. **Education and health:** Education and health should be equal with resources and that too free.
11. **One time food in a day should be made available free.** For this purpose a sum of Rs. 3000 pm should be given to a woman and unemployed youth in cities and Rs. 2000 pm. in villages.
12. **Justice:** Time bound. For example cheque bouncing case – one hearing or one month whichever is earlier. No case in any court should take more than six hearings or six months whichever is earlier.
13. **Reservation:** Reservation policy if any required in the country and that should be such which unites the countrymen instead of breaking them.

What is the need for the Reservation? – As on today opportunities are less and people who are seeking are many more. If the situation is reversed then do you feel that anyone will seek reservation – **Certainly not!** That situation can be created by the implementation of reforms suggested i.e. build 50-100 houses in every village along with the cottage industries. Implement all the projects under Equalization tax scheme, detail of the projects are given below under point number 20

14. **Water (Jal), air (Vayu) and climate (Jalvayu):** To have a complete solution of Global warming, a proper care should be taken for **water, air and climate.** **As Jal + Vayu = Jalvayu.** For this purpose the following steps should be taken:-

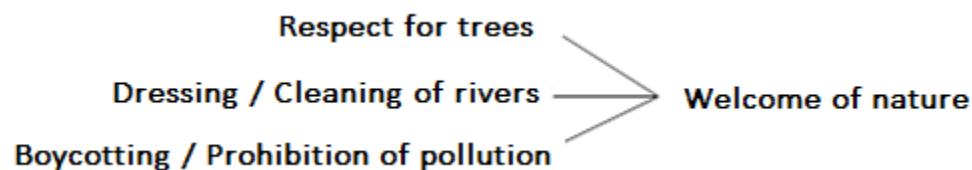
Water - All sources of water should be kept clean i.e. rivers, ponds, lakes, waterfalls, wells, water bodies etc. Rain water harvesting and building at least one pond in every village should be implemented.

Air - For this purpose cycle should ply with in 5 km, otherwise battery and electricity operated vehicles should ply and encouraged. Every person should plant a tree and up bring it like a child for the sake of children and for the self.

Climate - Climate of any place depends upon the quality of water and air of a particular place. If both are clean, automatically climate will be better and *vice versa*.

Pollution - Cause of Global warming is mainly pollution of water and air which affects the climate of a particular place and in totality of the **Globe**. Pollution made by one country or another, everyone is affecting the Globe. A country that is doing less pollution may be less affected but that country may be affected partially by the pollution of other countries.

For having a **complete solution of Global warming**, there is only one solution and that is:-



Other than this, there is no Solution in the world to check Global warming and all countries will have to make an effort in this direction jointly.

15. **Social Evils:** Feticide/ dowry – To check these, a Registration of property should be made compulsory in the name of women only. Gambling – For this purpose speculative trading of shares should be banned which is the main cause of legal gambling etc. By circulation of coins this menace will reduce drastically. **Intoxication**- Awareness should be spread that intoxication is harmful for body, mind and intellect. This can be controlled with the help of *Ante Pooja* (Inner worship) and method of that can be learnt from Purn Guru Ji.
16. **Distribution of resources:** Every person should get an equal share in the profit/ property (which is under the earth i.e. natural resources etc) of the country. Distribution of money in the states should be on the basis of population of a particular state. Money of Religious organizations belongs to the public and that should be used for the public only.
17. **Police Reforms:**
Working hours should be 28 in a week. At present it is 24x7 which affects their health very badly. Salary should be double. If a person is having stomach outside his belt, he should resign himself. (A reasonable time should be allowed to keep them physically fit).
18. **Judiciary Reforms:**
In every case a time limit should be fixed on the basis of the nature of the case. For example cheque dishonor case i.e. one hearing or one month whichever is earlier. There should be a bench of High court in every five districts and a bench of Supreme Court in every five states. All old/pending cases should be closed.
19. **Political Reforms:**
Election of P.M. and C.M. should be directly by the public. Pension of M.P. and M.L.A. should be equal to their salary and **should not have any other source of income. If a person (self, spouse and minor children) is having any immovable property, that should be donated to the country.** By these provisions, entry will be only for those politicians who really wish to serve the nation.
- Bureaucracy:** It is said that bureaucracy is not having back bone. When all the above three systems (i.e. police, judiciary and political) are in place, automatically this system will also function properly (can be molded as desired).
20. **Development of Infrastructure:-** Infrastructure of the country can be developed with the help of Equalization tax and is related to the following:-
- Infrastructure/social/welfare/charitable projects under Equalization tax:-** Management of water, air, transport, tourism, energy, housing, disabled, waste, agriculture, village/urban development, cottage industry, cooperative movement, stadium/place for social and cultural activities, control of pollution, free distribution of goods and services, acts for providing livelihood, inter caste/community marriages etc.
- All this can be done with the help of Equalization tax and also by taking a loan of any amount required for the above projects @ 0.01% p.a. interest by the government which is never refundable/payable.**
21. **To bring an Equality:** A limit of Income and Assets should be fixed. For this purpose loan should be given @ 0.01% p.a. interest to all who are having caliber or capacity or potential or qualification or any special feature.

22. **To improve a capacity:** An outing for a month should be made compulsory for every citizen of the country, to improve their capacity. For this purpose, bank account of every person should be credited with Rs. 1 crore and whatever amount he spends in a month it is fine and the balance amount should be returned. He should not be allowed to use this money other than for the purpose of tourism only. It will improve capacity of every citizen in the country. This can be implemented only after few years, once infrastructure in the country is ready.

23. **Respect for the women:** To improve respect for the women – Registration of property should be made compulsory in the name of women only, who will eradicate feticide and dowry problem to a great extent and every parent will wish that they should have a girl child only, which will help in improving the respect for the women. It will help Muslim women also, who are suffering due to abuse of Talak, Talak, Talak (divorce) and polygamy. All these factors will improve a respect for the women in the society.

24. **Security:** To provide security to every citizen of the country, a provision should be made for the pension and unemployment allowance as under:-

Minimum pension should be Rs. 5000 p.m. for every person who has completed a particular age. For the employees/ workers who are permanent, it should be 2.5% p.a. for every year completed or 50% of last salary drawn whichever is more and it should be based **on the last salary drawn or salary prevalent at present in the same cadre whichever is more.** It should be available to all the government and private employees and should be the responsibility of the government to pay rather than by the employer. Similarly, a provision should be made for an unemployment allowance of minimum of Rs. 5000 pm and Family pension between 50% to 75% of last salary drawn also on the basis of number of members in the family.

25. **Crime:** By implementation of coins instead of currency notes and ban on keeping arms and ammunition will help in reduction of crime to the tune of 95% to 100% of the following:-

Drugs, terrorism, maoism, adulteration, encouraging cast differentiation, gangsters, mafias, sale purchase of women and children, surveillance, extortion, cyber crime, contract killings, kidnapping, immoral and illegal acts by religious organizations, forged passport, human organs trade / professional blood donors , keeping weapons, forced begging, speculation, smuggling, hoarding, black marketing, fraudulent activities, sale/purchase of antiques, forgery related to financial matters, black mailing, encouraging immoral and illegal acts, receiving or paying graft, corruption etc.

26. **International Trade, Foreign Exchange and its relationship:** By implementation of the above provisions, one Rupee will be equal to one Dollar within a year's time of its implementation and in coming 10 years one Rupee may be equal to 100 Dollar, which will help in improving International relationship also.

27. **Funding of the Government:** To do all this government will be having plenty of money all the times and sources will be as under:-

From where the government will get the money once Income Tax is abolished:-

- **Manifold collection of taxes** (Excise, Sales tax & Service tax) and there will be no scope for evasion / theft of taxes after circulation of coins.
- **Equalization tax** from those who are not contributing towards the business or projects.

- **Government can borrow @ 0.01% p.a. interest**, any amount say 10/20/50/100...500 lac crore. As this amount is mere a book entry and circulation only, **which is not refundable/payable at all.**

In nutshell money of the country, will be used for the country, by the country, within the country and for the people of the country.

This way our country can become a Heaven and no power in this world will be able to stop all this to happen i.e. 'Our country Hindustan is a Heaven'

What is the cause of present state of affairs and only reason for that is **Corrupt Politics.**

Now let us examine/ analyze what is what:

Cause of Poverty, Corruption and Terrorism	– Corrupt Politics
Cause of Corrupt Politics	– Politics of Casteism
Cause of Politics of Casteism	– Caste System

But

All this can be changed/ done only by **Political reforms. Once Political reforms are made, the other reforms as mentioned above will follow automatically.**

Political Reforms:-

1. Election of P.M. and C.M. should be directly by the public.
2. Pension of M.P. and M.L.A. should be equal to their salary and **should not have any source of income.**
3. **If a person (self, spouse and minor children) is having any immovable property, that should be donated to the country.**
