

How every section of the society can get a guarantee of livelihood in the country?

When the following provisions are made:-

1. For a student education and health services should be equal, free and whatever is required for this purpose i.e. copy, pencil, books etc that should also be made available free. Lunch should be provided free.

The students who have studied in Hindustan, their loans should be waived off and the students who have studied abroad, their rate of interest should be made at 0.01% per annum.

2. For a farmer there should be a guarantee for the purchase of crops, a reasonable price at a reasonable time and compensation in case of damage of crops. Water of river and organic fertilizer should be made available free.

Jaggery (गुड़) should be produced in the villages by the farmers and for this purpose *kohlu* (crushing machines) should be installed. Minimum pension of Rs. 5000/- per month should be given to the farmers above the age of 60 years.

All existing loans of the farmers should be waived off.

3. A laborer should get his wages daily in the evening only. Cycle should ply and utensils of clay should be encouraged for better employment. Minimum pension of Rs. 5000/- per month should be given to the laborers above the age of 60 years. For permanent workers a provision of pension @2.5% per annum for every year completed or 50% of the last salary drawn, whichever is more should be made.
4. For an employee there should be duty of 28 hours in a week and work should be done all the seven days. A provision of pension should be made @2.5% per annum for every year completed or 50% of the last salary drawn, whichever is more.
5. For a businessman/self employed, there should be only three taxes i.e. Excise, Sales tax and Service tax and that should be progressive. Cottage industries and co-operatives should be encouraged. A provision for pension should be made, based on their contribution towards taxes or projects completed under Equalization tax during their lifetime; otherwise a minimum of Rs. 5000 p.m. should be given.

All loans of a laborer, an employee and a businessman/self employed up to Rs. 2 lac. should be waived off.

Disabled: (Includes- orphans, old and handicapped) – Every disabled person depends upon any one of the above sections of the society. Their life can't be prosperous until or unless every section of the society is prosperous and is having a guarantee of livelihood. For disabled such homes should be built wherein all these can live together in a separate wing of the same complex.

Special arrangements should also be made for the parents of the handicapped children, to end this question arising in their mind “What about these children after their death”. Such homes should be built in every block of villages and cities. A special arrangement should be made in every such home for physiotherapy and nursing by having a school within premises. All modern facilities should be provided there free of cost. Those facilities can be created very easily with the help of an Equalization tax

If you wish that our country Hindustan should become a Heaven, it is a essential that every section of the society should get a guarantee of livelihood i.e. student, farmer, laborer, employees and businessman/self employed and a special arrangement should be made for the disabled.
